5 ENTERIC DISEASES

a Foodborne disease outbreaks reported to the NICD, January—June 2017




Figure 8. Map of South Africa showing provincial (thick) and district (thin) demarcations, indicating the approximate location of 31 food-borne illness events reported to the NICD from January to June 2017. Numbers correspond to Table 1 on page 9.

Thirty-one food-borne illness (FBI) events were reported to the NICD during January to June 2017 as listed in Table 1, and illustrated in Figure 8. No FBIs were reported from North West, Limpopo or the Northern Cape provinces. Specimens were submitted for 18/23 events where details were reported, and pathogens isolated from only five of these. Notification, investigation and reporting of food-borne illness events can be strengthened.
