

**GERMS-SA** laboratory surveillance: **ALL** laboratories, please submit the following bacterial or fungal pathogens to the National Institute for Communicable Diseases (NICD) on Dorset transport medium with a TrakCareLab/ private laboratory report. Alternatively, send specimen tube/blood culture bottle if uncertain of identification and/or no isolate cultured (please contact NICD reference lab before sending).
