Feces Contaminated food or water	VaccinePractice good hygiene	No specific medication available Treated through supportive care (rest, adequate nutrition, and fluids) to help relieve symptoms
Through contact with the blood or bodily fluids of an infected person	 Vaccine Practice safe sex Blood screening 	Combination antiviral therapies (with Tenofovir or Tenofovir derivatives plus lamivudine)
Blood-to-blood contact	 Practice safe sex Avoid sharing needles, toothbrushes, razors or nail scissors 	Combination therapies with direct acting antivirals (DAAs)
Contact with infected blood (only occurs in people already infected with hepatitis B)	 Hepatitis B vaccine Avoid sharing needles, toothbrushes, razors or nail scissors 	Interferon
Feces Contaminated food or water	 Practice Good Hygiene Avoid drinking water that has come from a potentially unsafe source Cook food well 	No specific medication available Supportive Care
